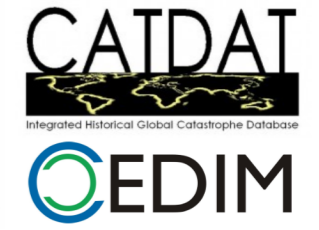

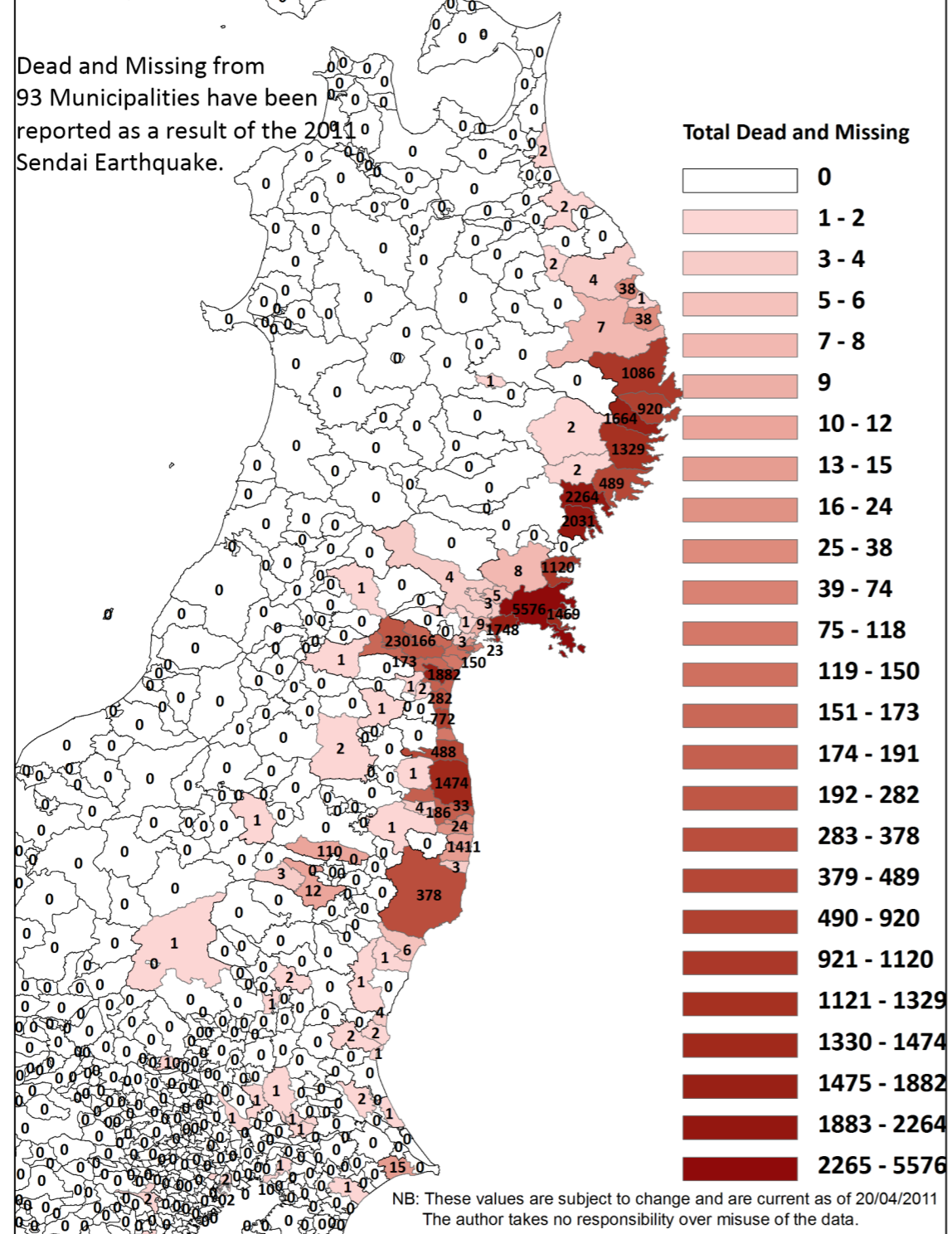

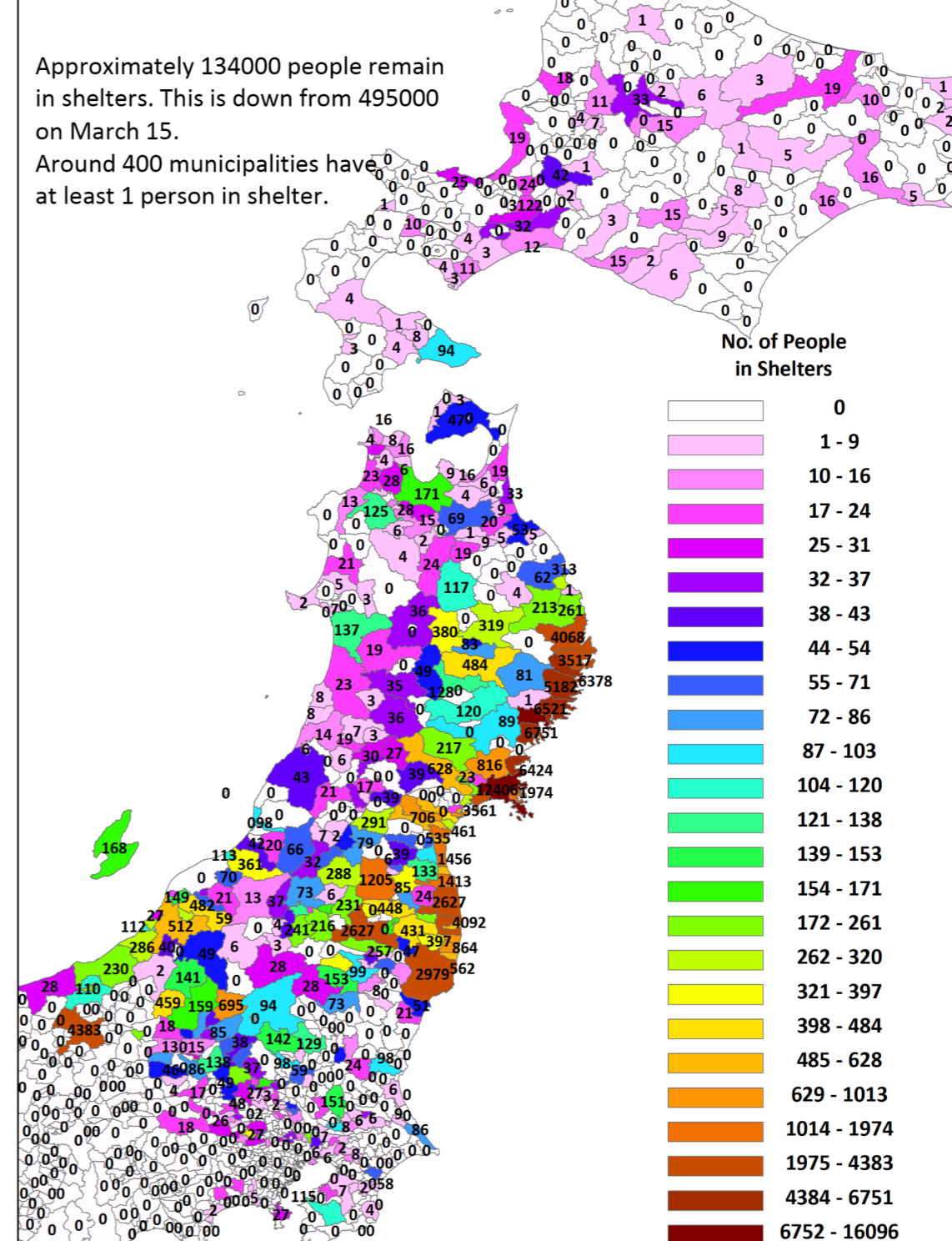
Dead and Missing from 93 Municipalities have been reported as a result of the 2011 Sendai Earthquake.

Approximately 134000 people remain in shelters. This is down from 495000 on March 15. Around 400 municipalities have at least 1 person in shelter.
